Sports 2000 Enduro Race (Race 6) Refuelling during Pitstops

With regard to the above race the subject of refuelling during this specific race is covered and allowed under the Sports 2000 Championship Regulation 2.4.1(c) as detailed below:

No work shall be carried out on the car, until the car comes to a complete standstill and the engine is stopped. The driver may remain in the car, unless refuelling is taking place.

The engine must not be restarted until all work is completed and the driver is seated in the car with all the belts done up correctly.

Refuelling will be permitted providing Motorsports UK Yearbook regulations (Q) 12.25.1 to 12.25.4 are complied with. The only exception is that closed loop (dry break) refuelling rigs are not permitted.

Refuelling must only be carried out at the beginning or end of the pit stop. While refuelling is being carried out, the car must remain on its wheels and no other work carried out on the car.

Further to the above each team planning to carry out refuelling during the race must have the refueller suitably protected with fireproof overalls, gloves and helmet and/or flame-retardant balaclava & goggles. Whilst the refuelling is being undertaken there must be another team member in similar protection with a suitable extinguisher (e.g. no CO2) providing fire cover.

It is each team's responsibility to be fully aware of the Sports 2000 Enduro Pitstop regulations as per sections 2.4.1 (a) to (h) inclusive of the 2023 published Sports 2000 Championship regulations prior to the event.
