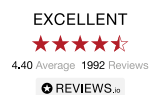

One month on and we are two events in to our 2020 Bennetts British Superbike Championship. While condensed in time the series hasn't been short of action, with five different winners gracing the top step of the Superbike podium after our visits to Donington Park and Snetterton. We look ahead to our weekend in Silverstone on the National circuit, to see if anyone else can join the winners circle.



We are hoping that it won't be long before spectators are allowed at the rounds as you are all very much missed! With that being said, Bennetts are working closely with the race organisers, teams and riders to ensure that our social media platforms keep you all up to date with the latest news and insight. Then there's the Bennetts BSB app providing live-timing and trackside radio, which I hope you enjoy.

The trio of Superbike races gave us nothing short of excitement. Snetterton delivered some real, hard-fought racing, resulting in a different podium line-up each time. With a Ducati Panigale V4R sweep taking round four by storm, soon to be unhinged by Glenn Irwin and Honda Racing's CBR1000RR-R Fireblade SP, as he took runner-up to Brookes at round five and to later climb to the top step for round six. It was also really great to see Christian Iddon on the top step 10 years after making his BSB debut.

Now we're six races in to 2020, Glenn Irwin's consistency is paying off as he leads the championship with 118 points, followed by Tommy Bridewell who is 23 points behind Irwin. The VisionTrack Ducati duo of Iddon and Brookes round off the placing of Ducatis in third and fourth respectively, with Jason O'Halloran currently holding fifth in the championship on board his McAMS Yamaha, ahead of Honda's Andrew Irwin who didn't quite have the same weekend as he had at the season opener...

Away from the top class, Rory Skinner is absolutely dominating Supersport on his Yamaha R6 and Tom Neave provided some exciting racing in the Superstock 1000 class. After his successes at Donington, he pulled it off when it counted and raced to victory on the penultimate lap of another nail-biting Superstock race on the new Honda Fireblade.

From everyone at Bennetts, we hope you enjoy the action and stay safe!

With six races so far in this late-starting season, it's been great to enjoy watching five different race winners with some huge surprises and a new winner on the top-step of the podium including Christian Iddon.

Current championship leader, Glenn Irwin, has consistently been a front-runner with the brand-new Honda CBR1000 RR-R Fireblade SP, but the Ducati V4Rs of Iddon, Josh Brookes and Tommy Bridewell are all incredibly fast too. As always in Bennetts BSB, there are at least 10 riders representing a long list of different manufacturers who are capable of winning - I can't wait to watch them battle it out on our National circuit!

Our thrilling National circuit means short lap times and it always delivers incredibly close and hard-fought racing. I hope that you'll be able to catch some of the excitement by watching the action on Eurosport.

Finally, I'd like to thank all our fans for their patience and support, we look forward to welcoming you back to Silverstone just as soon as it is safe to do so.



FANTASTIC FIVE

IDDON, BROOKES AND GLENN IRWIN ADD TO GROWING WINNERS' LIST IN 2020 AHEAD OF SILVERSTONE

Silverstone produced the closest race finish in last year's Bennetts British Superbike Championship and with five different race winners from six rounds, the stage is shaping up for the next thrilling installment of drama and intrigue in the battle for the 2020 title this weekend.

Honda Racing's Glenn Irwin still heads the championship standings ahead of the next three races this weekend; he has a 23-point margin at the top, courtesy of becoming the fifth different winner of the season at Snetterton.

The CBR1000RR-R Fireblade SP has already been a revelation this season, exceeding expectations in its debut season and the Irwin brothers will be pushing to maintain their podium finishing momentum this weekend.

On the opposite side of the garage Andrew Irwin had a difficult weekend at Snetterton; a crash in round four followed by an incident with Ryan Vickers meant he failed to score points in two races despite his rapid pace. A single eighth place finish means he arrives at Silverstone now sixth in the standings, so he will be pushing for a return to the top three this weekend.

Tommy Bridewell arrives at Silverstone leading the Ducati

charge following a hat trick of podium finishes last time out for the Oxford Products Racing Ducati team. The consistency from the Donington Park race winner has put him within striking distance of Glenn Irwin at the top of the standings and he will be pushing for the top step of the podium again this weekend.

Christian Iddon finally got the monkey off his back in the opening race at Snetterton to claim his first win in the Bennetts British Superbike Championship; the multiple Riders' Cup champion scored VisionTrack Ducati their first victory of 2020, and followed it up with a podium finish in the final race.

There are only four points between the VisionTrack Ducati teammates though, and 2015 champion Josh Brookes climbed the order in the standings at Snetterton. The Australian celebrated his 50th career win in the series and a second place, as he made amends for the non-points score in the final race at Donington Park following the much talked about incident with Andrew Irwin.

The McAMS Yamaha team were a real force to be reckoned with at Silverstone last year, and currently Jason O'Halloran and Tarran Mackenzie sit fifth and seventh in the standings.



O'Halloran was on the podium at Donington Park but they will be expecting more in the three races this weekend in their bid to move closer to the top of the standings.

The FS-3 team have a new look for the remainder of the season and the Rapid Fulfillment FS-3 Kawasaki squad will be hoping for a podium finishing return with their new sponsor onboard. Danny Buchan has a bruising weekend at Snetterton, but he was a podium finisher at Silverstone last season and Lee Jackson narrowly missed the top three twice last time out, so the official Kawasaki team will want to bag their first podium finishes of 2020 this weekend.

Buildbase Suzuki have shown they have the pace to be at the sharp end of the competition too and with Kyle Ryde edging ever increasingly closer the leading fight, could this be the weekend where he claims a debut podium finish? On the opposite side of the garage Gino Rea made his debut with the team at Snetterton and was pushing for top tens, so he could also be a dark horse for a strong result here.

Bradley Ray had a resurgent weekend for SYNETIQ BMW last time out at Snetterton, claiming his best result of

the season with a fifth place in the opening race of the weekend; he will be determined to haul himself up the standings this weekend in the battle of the BMWs.

Luke Mossey meanwhile leads the Rich Energy OMG Racing BMW teammates, and is just two points adrift of Ray. The OMG team claimed their first win on the National circuit with Josh Elliott last season so they will be hoping that the shorter, hectic lap here at Silverstone could put them back into contention again.

There is also a list of riders arriving here wanting to make up for some disappointing results at Snetterton by their high standards including Peter Hickman, Danny Buchan who crashed twice, and Ryan Vickers, who had an incident with Andrew Irwin and then a crash in the final race of the weekend.

The end of Silverstone will mark the halfway point in the season and with no Showdown this year, points are going to be vital here this weekend for championship aspirations...

Iddon lights up Snetterton with first Bennetts BSB win



Christian Iddon firmly removed the monkey from his back at Snetterton last time out, claiming his first ever Bennetts British Superbike Championship race win, and VisionTrack Ducati's first victory of the 2020 season.

Iddon had been a multiple podium finisher in the past; coming close to victory on multiple occasions, but the previous Riders' Cup champion admits that it is simply just another tick on the list of goals for this season.

"The win has very narrowly evaded me a lot of times before, and I have been like within a tenth of a second of the win three or four times before.

"That was frustrating so I don't know whether it was actually bothering me; a couple of years ago it was starting to grate on me, as I had been getting so close and then through one thing or another we weren't really in the fight last year and so it had stopped bothering me," reflected Iddon.

Joining the most successful team in the paddock for the new season, Iddon knew that nothing less than wins and

podiums would suffice after joining the VisionTrack Ducati team.

"This year I knew the package that I was on, we would expect that, so it was more of a nice thing to do it and nicer in the manner in which it was done," added Iddon. "I had led the race for pretty much the entirety, certainly since the restart and I was in front and hit all the markers. It wasn't a race than involved any strangeness, I set my own pace and that was enough to win.

"It's kind of weird as I don't feel that elated by it, because that is what I have always expected of myself the whole time so when I did it, it was more of an expectation I have had for a long time and a relief to get it done."

The championship now moves on to Silverstone; a circuit where the team scored a single podium finish last season with Scott Redding at the opening round, and Iddon is ready to take the weekend in his stride.

"We are taking each weekend as it comes," added Iddon. "We went into Snetterton knowing that it isn't one of my favourite tracks but also despite being injured last year,

that I had pretty good results there. After qualifying, I was only seventh but I was really happy as I had a good feeling with the bike, so when we got to the grid I was feeling really quite confident and it worked out that way.

"On the Sunday I wasn't really feeling the same and it sort of showed in the results, so I think you have to take it as it comes and when you feel you can ride the bike well, which I thought I could in the first and third races at Snetterton, then it comes to you.

"As long as I can ride the bike how I want then the results should come, but the elation of winning my first BSB race lasted until turn one and then I was already thinking about the next two races. It is a bit like ticking a box waiting to move onto the next bigger box at the end of the season."

Iddon remains confident of coming out for the next three races and being in the battle to repeat the performance, admitting that he has been getting more comfortable on the Ducati after the recent rounds.

"If we can continue the form that we are on and on an upward trend then you know that will be mint," said Iddon. "I feel like every time I have ridden the bike on a race weekend I have been making progress. I had been getting frustrated during testing because I didn't feel I wasn't making progress and I knew what the bike was capable of, but it wasn't until the first race at Donington that it was really my bike and that feeling has continued to get stronger. I am hoping I can just carry on that trend.

"I enjoy the Silverstone circuit; it is obviously a bit of a scratchers circuit so it is going to be super close as it always is in BSB regardless, but a short track and not a great deal of technicality to it, it really amplifies how close the times will be. That is going to be interesting. Last year it was the first round, which always produces some anomalies so I feel good about it and there are a few things we are working on, which some teams are too, so if we can resolve that it will unlock some more potential."
