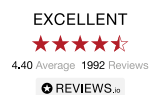

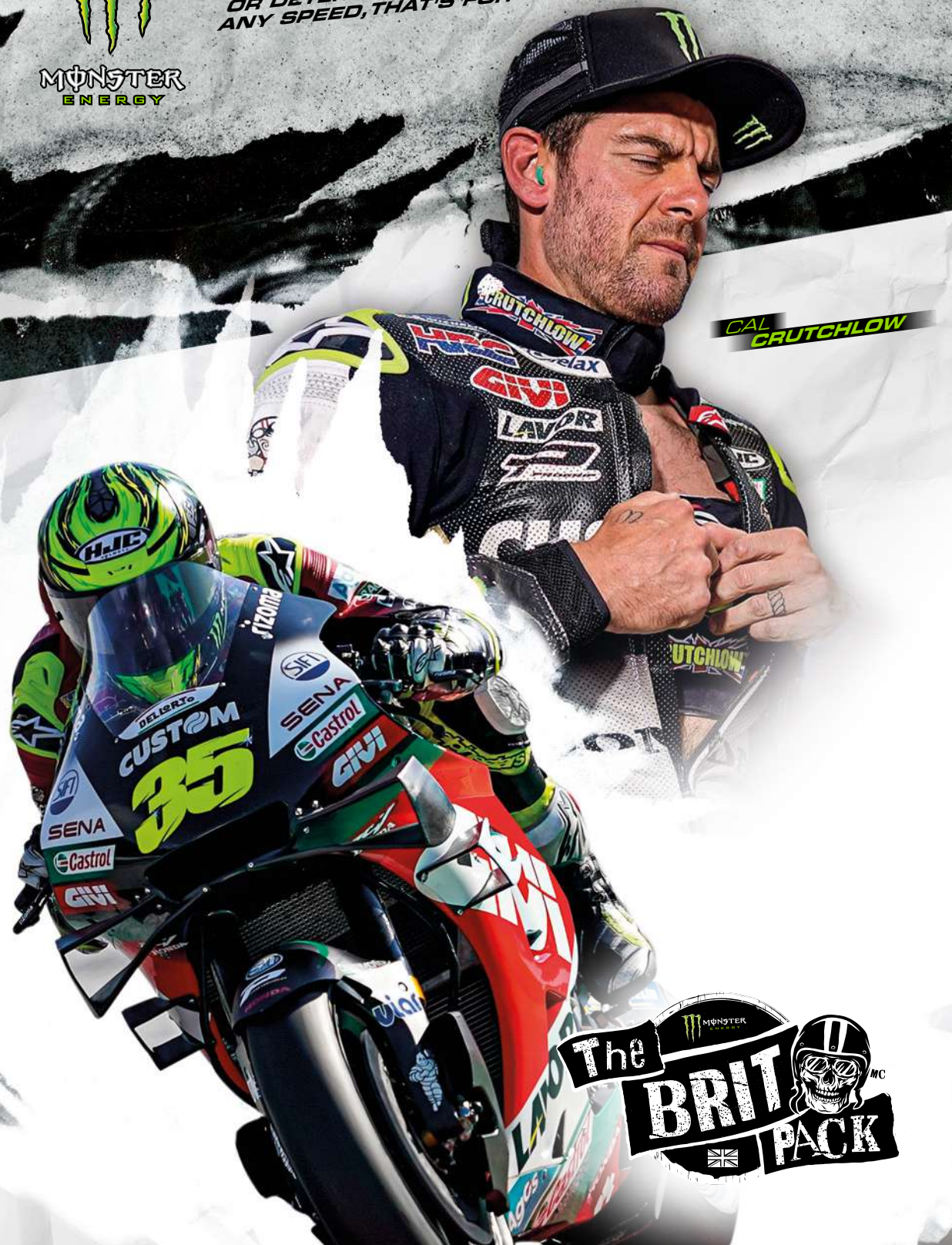

I am very pleased to welcome the Bennetts British Superbike Championship to Brands Hatch for the final three rounds of this year's championship, and what I'm certain will be a hugely entertaining finale. It seems strange to be welcoming Bennetts BSB to Brands Hatch on just the one occasion this season, but I'm delighted we're here at all after the trying circumstances of 2020.



It is hugely disappointing, however, that Bennetts BSB fans cannot be trackside this weekend. This championship has the most passionate and knowledgeable fan base in the UK, and they have been greatly missed in their absence. My team at MSV has worked extremely hard to put COVID-secure protocols in place to enable us to welcome fans in limited numbers, as we have for many other race meetings. A completely outdoors event, across a huge parkland site, is clearly much safer than many indoor activities that are allowed to continue to operate, and it's very frustrating for everyone involved that we find ourselves in this position.

Fans will still be able to tune in from home - this weekend's action will be broadcast on Eurosport 2, with live coverage of all of the key moments including Saturday's qualifying session and opening race ahead of the final two races of the year on Sunday. It will make for compelling viewing with five riders in contention for the crown - it seems we're having a showdown after all!

Seasoned contender Josh Brookes will be many people's pick for the title as he leads the standings from VisionTrack Ducati teammate Christian Iddon. The Australian will also face tough opposition from Glenn Irwin, who led the way for much of the summer on the new Honda Fireblade, plus McAMS Yamaha duo Jason O'Halloran and Tarran Mackenzie.

Others to look out for will include Tommy Bridewell, Andrew Irwin, and Kyle Ryde, whilst established stars like Danny Buchan, Bradley Ray, and Peter Hickman will be aiming to end the season on a high. The level of competition in Bennetts BSB has been sensationally good this year!

I'm sure you will enjoy this weekend's three races from wherever you're watching. I hope you keep safe and well during the off-season - we'll see you in 2021!

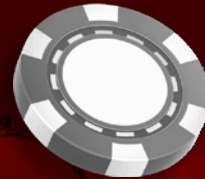




IT'S TIME TO GO



ALL IN



The winner really does take all this weekend as an incredible Bennetts British Superbike Championship season reaches its climax on the legendary Brands Hatch Grand Prix circuit, with a five-way fight to become the 2020 champion.

Glenn Irwin had held the lead in the title chase up until now, but Josh Brookes arrives at Brands Hatch top of the pile and leading his closest rival by 16-points, with just a further three covering the top four riders.

Meanwhile Tarran Mackenzie still has a mathematical shot with a 46-point deficit with a maximum stake of 75-points available from the three races.

Of the last ten races on the Grand Prix circuit, Brookes has won seven and so is a formidable contender as PBM bid to add to their unsurpassed championship-winning pedigree of title number eight in the guise of VisionTrack Ducati.

The closest opposition ahead of the three rounds this weekend is Brookes' VisionTrack Ducati teammate Christian Iddon, who is in title contention for the first time as he bids to deny his Australian rival his second Bennetts BSB title.

The VisionTrack Ducati teammates are separated by 16-points, but as we have seen on so many occasions this year, the fortunes can change in an instant and 2020 has become one of the most unpredictable seasons in recent times.

More than ready to take on the red corner though is the opposition in black as Honda Racing bid to end their sensational debut season with a title win for the new CBR1000RR-R Fireblade SP.

Glenn Irwin had his advantage slashed after a crash in the opening race at Donington Park, but he has never been more determined as he targets his first Bennetts BSB title and he will also have a wingman in brother Andrew, who was a race-winner last time out.

Glenn Irwin only trails Iddon by two points, but in turn, the Honda Racing rider only holds a single point advantage over the third team and

manufacturer in contention for 2020 glory – McAMS Yamaha in the hands of Jason O'Halloran.

O'Halloran is another rider in title contention at the season finale for the first time and after suffering disappointment at Donington Park following a collision with Iddon left the clutch lever caught behind the guard, causing the clutch to be semi engaged and subsequently dropped him down the field.

The Australian knows that the 19-point deficit to Brookes can be overturned across the final three Rounds and that a podium in Round 16 is going to be crucial ahead of Sunday's final two races.

Mackenzie meanwhile knows he has a long shot, but also that he could be the joker in the pack, should bad luck strike the riders ahead of him as he bids to add to his two victories this season, in his strongest campaign to date for McAMS Yamaha.

Whilst the five contenders are the only riders mathematically able to take the title; there are a queue of riders who won't be holding back to end their season on a high. The additional three race winners in 2020 – Tommy Bridewell for Oxford Products Racing Ducati, Andrew Irwin on the second of the Honda Racing Fireblades, and Buildbase Suzuki's Kyle Ryde are all eager to repeat their previous success.

Meanwhile, Rapid Fulfillment FS-3 Kawasaki's Lee Jackson and Danny Buchan have both been podium finishers and nothing would end their 2020 campaigns better than Kawasaki's first win of the season.

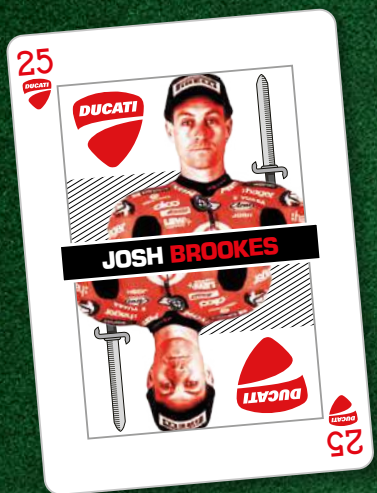
Luke Mossey arrives at Brands Hatch leading the BMW contenders; the Rich Energy OMG Racing BMW rider two points ahead of SYNETIQ BMW's Bradley Ray, who was sidelined with a leg injury at Donington Park, so will want more this weekend at his home round.

In 2020 we have missed having our fans trackside with us to witness the action firsthand, but this weekend Brands Hatch is sure to deliver a sensational end to a hallmark season of Bennetts BSB.

JOSH BROOKES VISIONTRACK DUCATI

“Leading the championship after the final race was a nice way to leave Donington Park. I didn’t give up on having another chance in the last race there, but in my mind I knew it was an important race to finish and that I couldn’t afford to have any DNFs so they rode well and deserve their places.”

“It feels good to lead into the final event. Normally I go into Brands Hatch trailing in the points and trying to claw back a desperate chance at the championship, so to go with a lead is a great improvement on years before.”

“I like the track and we have often had good results at Brands Hatch so I just need to focus on doing a good job, work hard and what will be, will be.”

CHRISTIAN IDDON VISIONTRACK DUCATI

“How am I going to approach this weekend? I don’t know really! It’s a good position to be in and I’ve never been in this position before in BSB, but I have been in this position before in other times in my career.”

“This year I’ve tried to approach every race race-by-race, lap-by-lap, and situation-by-situation and so far it has been pretty good. It’s easier to be the chaser and not the chased, so I don’t really care whether I finish second or fifth, it’s the being first that makes the big difference – in the championship I mean.”

“It’s all to play for and it’s going to be interesting. You never know how you feel on the bike until you swing a leg over on that first free practice and hopefully I will have a good feeling. All I ever do is my best and I feel good about it. I know that when I get a good feeling, like I had at Snetterton, like I had at Oulton Park, that I’ve got the pace required to do the job in hand.”



GLENN IRWIN HONDA RACING

“Going into the last round, I’m aware of how big of a task it is.. Our points deficit is what it is, it’s a huge task because Josh has shown phenomenal form on the GP track in recent years. For me to win this championship I’ll have to beat Josh in all three races. Also, Christian and Jason are riding really, really well.”

“To be honest it’s a real testament to Honda and their new Fireblade. To build up a points lead during that period was an amazing achievement and where that has put us now. As much as it’s a huge task, it’s a big chance as well.”

“I go into the last round with a lot of hope and the realism that we can be the champion but I don’t underestimate how difficult of a job that will be. What will be will be. It has been a great year for me regardless and I think we’ve established ourselves as one of the main front runners and that has taken a lot of work. Either way, I have a lot of satisfaction this season and we just go and throw everything I have at it and that’s for sure!”

“Let’s go and enjoy it, get stuck in and try to complete what has been a dream season for the new Fireblade.”

JASON O’HALLORAN MCAMS YAMAHA

“We have a little bit more of a point’s deficit now after Donington Park, but it is not the end of the world; it’s only 19 points, so it’s still well within reach.”

“I like racing at Brands Hatch, I’ve had some really good races there in the past. I can’t wait to race there on the new Yamaha this year because we’ve been stronger at some tracks where we’ve struggled a little bit last year and I think this will be one of them circuits where we improve quite a lot from where we were last season.”

“I’m expecting to be strong. Who knows what’s coming up at the end of October but it’ll be really nice to have three dry races to battle out for the championship between the top guys and see where we end up.”

“Obviously, Saturday will be an important day for us to try and beat our competitors and make sure we take the title fight right down to the last race on Sunday, and see if we can manage to lift the trophy on Sunday afternoon.”



TARRAN MACKENZIE MCAMS YAMAHA

“To come back in the last race and be back on the top step at Donington Park was a big thing going into the last round especially.”

“Being 46 points off is obviously still a long way to be off the championship lead but it’s almost nice in a way going in with no pressure and just enjoying the last three races and getting the best results I can and then the championship will sort itself out really.”

“Going into the last round, Brands Hatch is a track that I’ve been strong at in the past, so there’s no reason why I can’t go and fight for three wins there.”

KERSHAW AND CHARLWOOD HOLD THE ADVANTAGE AHEAD OF DOUBLE POINT DECIDER

A huge entry is set to end the Molson Group British Sidecar Championship, with the addition of some international flavour with the addition of the Santander Salt International Sidecar Superprix, ending the season with a feast of action on the Grand Prix circuit.

2018 champion Steve Kershaw and his new passenger Ryan Charlwood, a double champion, hold a 56-point lead in the standings ahead of Sam and Adam Christie on their Christie Engineering Services Yamaha, but with double points, it isn't over just yet.

The Beverley based brothers will need to produce the ride of a lifetime to hang onto their position, because reigning champions Todd Ellis and Charlie Richardson, plus multiple World champion Tim Reeves are back from Germany where they attacked part one of the Superprix.

Reeves, however, cannot win the title, as he has scored in just one round with a maximum fifty points from Snetterton.

Behind the top three, there has been great action from fourth placed Tommy Philp and Tom Bryant. The newcomers on their Roberts Construction/Tops Autos Yamaha were a revelation at Donington Park in the previous round, taking 38-points away with them.

The next four crews are split by just 15-points with Phil Bell and Jimmy Connell leading the charge from Ricky Stevens and Jonny Allum, Lewis Blackstock and Paddy Rosney and their Silicone Barnes Racing rivals John Holden and Jake Lowther.

Then in ninth place it is Robb Biggs/Jeroen Schmitz ahead of Tim Reeves/Kevin Rousseau.

Add to this bevy of talent the colourful foreign additions and we have a great spectacle to look forward to this weekend.

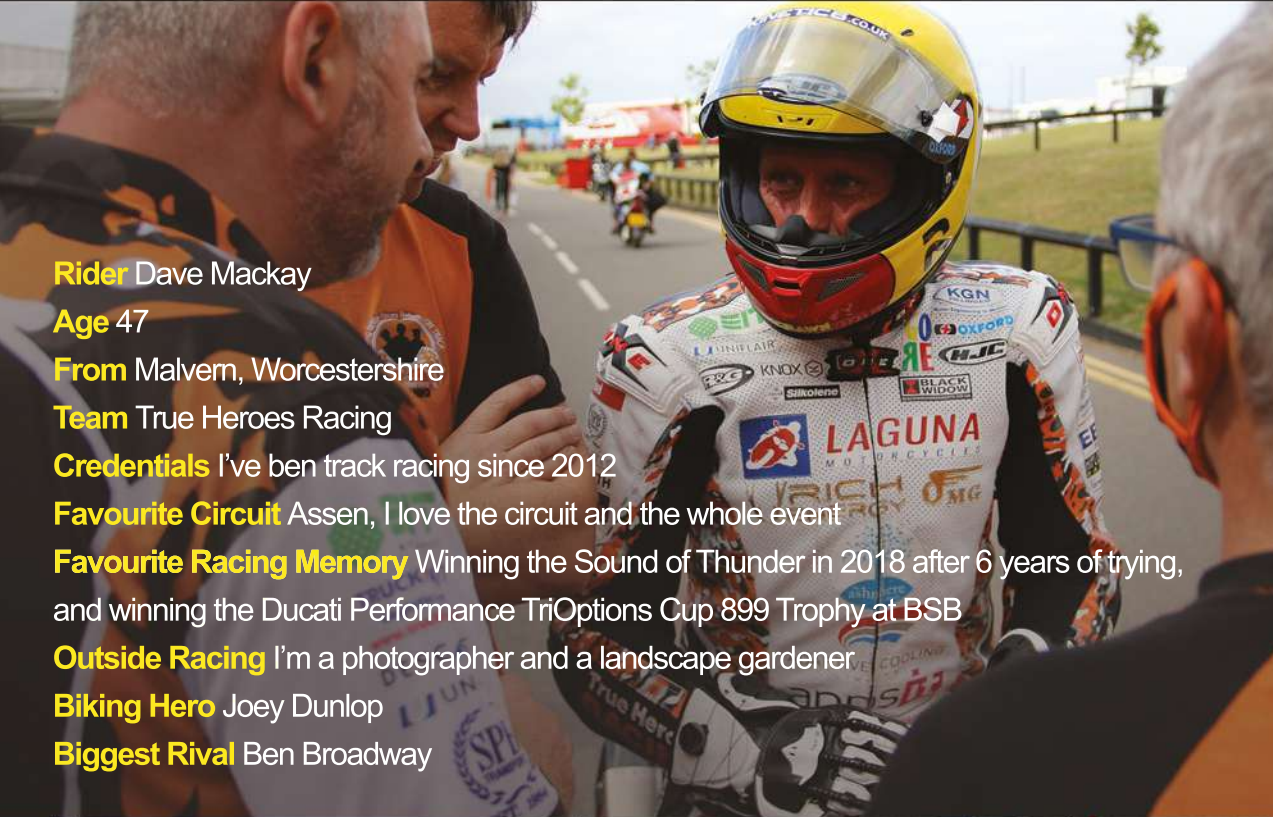

ROUSE VERSUS NEAVE AS 2020 TITLE TO BE DECIDED AT BRANDS HATCH

There are now just ten points separating Chrissy Rouse and Tom Neave in the battle for the Pirelli National Superstock 1000 Championship title fight with just one race remaining at Brands Hatch to decide the 2020 champion.

Tim Neave was back on the podium at Donington Park and the Buildbase Suzuki rider is just two-points adrift of McConnell ahead of the final race of the season so he will be gunning of a repeat of his Silverstone victory this weekend.

Tom Neave clawed back the advantage at Donington Park with a third place and a win to put the Honda Racing team into contention for the final round.

Danny Kent had his best result of the season at Donington Park, claiming a second place finish for the Morello Racing Kawasaki team, giving him a six-point advantage over Fraser Rogers, who was recently a podium finisher at Oulton Park.

Rouse's run of six podium finishes was ended last time out, but two top five finishes means he arrives at Brands Hatch still holding the position at the top of the standings.

Damon Rees, Luke Hedger and Davey Todd currently complete the top ten in the standings ahead of the final race of the season on the Grand Prix circuit, with contenders including Ian Hutchinson and Dan Linfoot also wanting to end 2020 on a high.

Lewis Rollo currently lies third in the championship standings; the IN Competition Aprilia rider was back on the podium last time out, but Billy McConnell's race win at Donington Park has fired the Rich Energy OMG Racing BMW rider to within seven points.

The front tyre is crucial for giving a rider confidence and 'feel'. The 2020 spec tyre has a wider contact patch, for more stability as the rider 'drops into' a corner. 

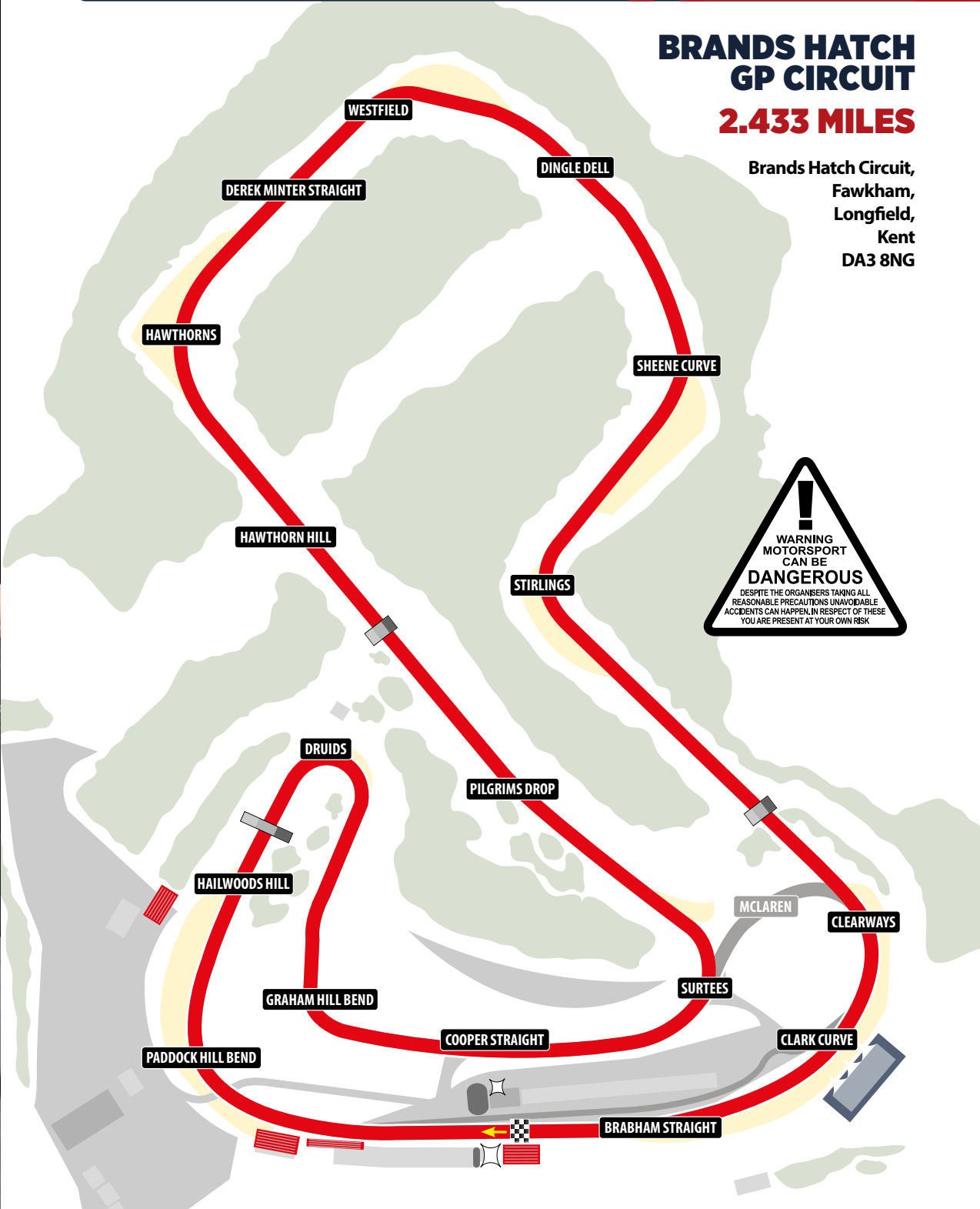
