Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Championship Regulation(s):

CR34.17 Unsafe release from pit stop

### **Brief Details:**

Car 32 was reported for making light contact with 95 whilst attempting to re join the fast lane. Both team manager interviewed, pit box video #32 reviewed. No further action to be taken.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

No Further Action - Team managers will speak to their car controllers

Additional Comments: Having interviewed both team managers, I am satisfied this was a minor error in a very congested pit lane. I have been reassured by both team managers that they will brief their pit lane personnel.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
