



## Admission for carers of disabled guests - important information

Carers of our disabled guests may be entitled to free admission at MSV's race events, however this must be arranged prior to the event. Anyone turning up on the day will not be able to obtain a free carer ticket.

To apply for a free carer ticket we require only one of the following documents as proof:

- A copy of the most recent DLA letter for care and/or mobility
- Receipt of Personal Independence Payment (PIP) showing the current entitlement
- A copy of your Attendance Allowance documentation

### How to apply

To apply for a carer ticket, either post your proof to the address

below or email [carer@msv.com](mailto:carer@msv.com) at least one week prior to the meeting you wish to attend. Alternatively, if you have an [Access Card](#), contact us quoting your name and ID number.

Please note that anyone under the age of 13 will be admitted free of charge and will therefore not be eligible for a free carer ticket.

### Guide and assistance dogs

### Disabled Parking

Two designated disabled parking areas for those with blue badges can be accessed from the main entrance. Please follow the highway signage into the main entrance of the venue and have your Blue Badge ready to show circuit staff. This will aid you being directed through the main entrance during times of high volume, and then on to the Knickerbrook area.

Places are limited and are available on a first-come, first-served basis on the day. Both areas allow visitors to remain in

their cars to spectate. Blue badge holder parking is on gravel, with a small grass overflow area towards Clay Hill. This may be unsuitable for wheelchairs or those who are unsteady on

their feet. Please contact any steward for assistance should you need any further help moving around the venue. The location has toilets and food concessions.

## Planning your visit to Oulton Park



### Parking

There is a dedicated parking area for disabled guests overlooking Knickerbrook, plus overflow parking towards Clay Hill. For details please see overleaf.



### Toilets

Toilets with disabled facilities can be found in multiple locations around the circuit. During major events, additional temporary disabled toilets are provided.



### Restaurant and Bars

The Chequers restaurant and bar is wheelchair friendly and has disabled toilet facilities.



### Medical Centre

The circuit medical centre is located in the race paddock.



### Grandstand Seating

Unfortunately there is no designated grandstand seating for disabled guests.
