DESCRIPTION

Legends Cars Championship with MRF Tyres is recognised as one of the most entertaining race series in Britain, offering close and exciting action in short-sharp races where reversed grids are a key feature.

SPECIFICATION

Legends Cars are 5/8 scale race cars based on pre-War Ford, Chevy and Dodge body styles. Eight body styles are produced and all cars are powered by the same 1250cc Yamaha motorcycle engines.

APPROX. COSTS

Base car: £6,000. Full season: £15,000.

POINTS AND REWARDS

Each day (round) of Legends Cars racing features two Heats and a Final. Points are awarded in both the Heats and Final each raceday, with the highest scoring drivers from the Heats starting at the back of the grid in the respective day's Final. Points are awarded on the basis 200-185-170-160-150-140 etc down to 20 points for 18th place. Awards are presented to the first three in each Final.

In addition to the main championship battle, there are also competitions for the Rookie Cup and Masters Cup – since last year the latter has been named the Gerard McCosh Napoleon Award in memory of the late Legends Cars racer and his famous cuddly toy pig mascot, Napoleon.

TECH TALK

DESCRIPTION

The Classic & Modern Motorsport Club (Southern) Intermarque Series is for Competitors participating in front engine silhouette saloon and sports coupe cars. These cars are to be based on production body shell shapes and recognisable as the make and model that the body shell is based on. They use a steel tubular chassis with fibreglass/Kevlar body panels. Front splitters and aerofoils are allowed along with extended wheel arches. The minimum weight including driver is 855 kilograms and all the cars use Avon Tyres, either slicks for the dry or grooved tyres for the wet.

APPROX. COSTS

New cars cost around £35,000 with second hand models around £25,000. A season's racing is approx. £10,000 with two races at each of the seven meetings.

Points are awarded on the basis of 200 for a race win, reducing by 10 points for each position down to 19th place. All other finishers get 20 points. Each race winner gets a trophy and the overall top three in the championship also receive trophies.
