

Knockhill NOTIFICATION OF SANCTION

According to the Judicial Procedures of the 2024 MCRCB Sporting Code we confirm our decision.

Motive

During the Knockhill British Superbike Race 1 your machine was observed to be emitting smoke. You were shown the black and orange flag and LED panel signal at multiple points, but continued at racing speed for almost three full laps. The black and orange flags and LED panel signals were first displayed at 17:05:10 and you entered pitlane at 17:07:43. This is an infringement of Article 1.4.3 of the 2024 MCRCB Sporting Code. Due to the prolonged hazard presented to yourself and other riders it is considered a serious infringement.

Hearing

You were required to attend a hearing with the Race Direction and acknowledged the incident.

Sanction

According to Article 2.8.3 of the 2024 MCRCB Judicial Procedures it is the decision of the Race Direction that you be penalised with 4 penalty points. This brings your accumulated penalty points to 6 points and as a result you must start your next race from the last grid position.


Right of Appeal

According to Art. F7 of the MCRCB Judicial Code, you have the right to appeal against this decision to the MCRCB Stewards within 30 minutes of the date and time of receipt of this decision. The appeal must be lodged in writing, stating the grounds for the appeal and accompanied by the appeal fee of £250.
