Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q 12.24.3 (e/f) Failure to comply with Yellow Flag signals

Brief Details:

Car 25 (Joshua Needham) overtook Car 34 (Roger Donnan) and Car 73 (Ashley Law) as the cars were travelling through Brooklands corner whilst Yellow Flag Light Panels were being displayed due to a car being a long way off circuit due to a mechanical issue. No marshals trackside at the time.

All drivers interviewed and on board video seen from all cars. Mitigating circumstances was that Cars 34 & 73 were on L/H side of track and lifted on seeing the Yellow Lights, Car 25 was potentially unsighted to the lights and to the R/H side of Cars 34 & 73 and overtook both on the exit to the corner. Driver apologised for the error, which was not intentional. Decision provided verbally to Mr Needham at 09.09hrs Sunday 14th April 24

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Addition of time to your race time
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 3

Additional Comments: 2 sec Time Penalty applied to the Race results of Race 3 (Sports 2000 Race 1) on Saturday 13th April 2024
