Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Section Q Appendix 3 (Safety Car) Failure to comply with Safety Car Regulations

### **Brief Details:**

During the safety car period car 11 was in the queue behind a back marker, car 89. On the last lap, car 89 allowed a significant gap to the cars in front and from on board the driver of 11 can be seen signalling to car 89 to keep up with the cars in front. Approaching the line car 11 can be seen to lift off but car 89 lifted off more. However, car 11 went on power and overtook car 89 before the line. Given the mitigation offered the action is limited to a formal reprimand.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
