Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q 12.21.4 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Driver approached coordinator to confirm he had caused car 42 to enter gravel trap. Review on board footage and saw that car 37 ran wide off track and through gravel at the Old Hairpin. He maintained pace and returned to the track and went right across width of track and made contact with 42, forcing him into the gravel trap, and spinning himself. Q12.21.3 requires cars leaving track to rejoin safely, driver 37 accepted he did not do so, and apologised. He added that he had already apologised to the other driver.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
