Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Series Regulation(s):

Eligibility - Post Race Scrutineering

Brief Details:

Following race 2, car 25 was measured ride height and found to be under the 120mm as per regulation 5.6.1.iii.b. Regulation 4.1.3 allows that if the height is under by less than 5mm the penalty is limited to that race only. The scrutineer confirmed the difference was less than 5mm.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the results of the race

Additional Comments: For clarity the appropriate regulation for the level of penalty is:

4.1.3 The penalty for the following technical infringements will be exclusion from the race results of only the race at which the offence was committed, forfeiting championship points, prize money and other awards. The result of that race does not have to be counted towards the championship if the car is:

- (i) Less than 5kg below the minimum weight specified in section 5.14 of these regulations.
- (ii) Less than 5mm below the minimum ride height specified in section 5.6.1 of these regulations.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
