### **Brief Details:**

Car 4 overtook Car 903 on the entry to Paddock Hill bend (Turn 1) while yellow light panels and yellow flags were being displayed. There was a telehandler in the gravel at time performing a Live Snatch operation on a car in the gravel. Driver was interviewed and admitted to the offence offering no mitigating circumstances.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
