Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Championship Regulation(s):

29.5 Joker Tyres

### **Brief Details:**

A report was received by the Eligibility Scrutineer in connection with tyre damage to car #78. Following the showing of the chequered flag at the end of Free Practice, the car #78 followed event procedure and left the track at T4 using the "cut through" to the pit lane. The car #78 was the first car to use this access and in so doing sustained tyre damage to all tyres from debris. The tyres were presented to the tyre manufacturer and the Eligibility scrutineer. Permission is granted to change all four tyres as additional tyres, not joker tyres.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
