Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q 12.24.3 (e/f) Failure to comply with Yellow Flag signals

Brief Details:

Verbal report from trackside post chief at post 11 stating that you overtook car 98 whilst yellow flag/light was being displayed. Drivers of both cars interviewed separately. The driver of car 98 states had a misfire and was travelling very slowly. You state similar when questioned and added that it would have been dangerous not to pass. In the absence of a written post chief report or video footage, I feel that I do not have sufficient evidence to issue a penalty on this occasion. I have reminded you of the need to adhere to regulations regarding yellow flags/lights

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
