Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

### **Brief Details:**

Contact between cars 78, 3 and 148 between Druids and Graham Hill Bend in Race 2 Saturday 1 July. Drivers of all cars interviewed and video from 3 and 148 plus circuit and spectator video.

Conclusion reached was that no one was predominantly at fault - it was a busy first lap with 3 cars in close proximity almost side by side. Car 78 was unsettled by the kerb on the exit of druids and the car moved slightly to the right and clipped, 3 then hit 148 causing 148 to half spin. 78 then made contact with 148.
