Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

### **Brief Details:**

Contact between cars 6 and 7 on the exit of Druids. Drivers interviewed and on board footage from Car 7 reviewed, along with circuit CCTV. No footage available from Car 6. The driver of Car 6 was considered to be predominantly at fault.
