Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q 12.21.1 Manoeuvres liable to hinder / Crowding

**Brief Details:**

Having reviewed the onboard camera footage of car #521 and circuit CCTV footage - footage shows that car #180 moved across the circuit, resulting in contact with car #521, causing car #180 to spin and continue. It was also noted that there was excessive braking after the race from car #180 which was unnecessary and avoidable.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
