## Brief Details:

Following a collision between CAR 27 (Leon Wilson) and Car 45 (Callum Baxter) a hearing was called before the Clerk of the Course, Deputy CofC and DSA. Attending were Wilson, Baxter with Team Manager/Guardian as appropriate. On board video was shown from both cars. It was clear that Wilson had left the track with all four wheels and when rejoining the circuit made contact with Baxter.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Grid Place Penalty Number of Licence Penalty Points: 3

Additional Comments: A 5 grid place penalty for the next Race at which Car 27 participates in GB4 and at which the penalty can be taken. The decision was delivered verbally to all parties at 19:45.
