Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q 12.21.4 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Car 66 and Car 17 were involved in an incident at Turn 4. Both drivers had left the circuit when called to see the Clerk but with agreement the respective team managers were shown an onboard video from Car 66. It was clear to the Clerk of the Course and the Driving Standards Advisor that Car 66 (Chloe Grant) was to blame for the contact. This was agreed by the two Team Managers.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Number of Licence Penalty Points: 3

Additional Comments: A 5 grid place penalty will be given at the next race in the 2024 GB4 Championship at which the driver competes and can be taken.
