Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

C1.1.5 Driving in a manner incompatible with general safety, and/or departing from the standard of a reasonably competent driver.

### **Brief Details:**

Car 26 left the circuit, and afterwards made contact with Car 31 at MP20 - Murrays, whilst attempting to re-join. Live footage was reviewed, as well as onboard footage from Cars 26 and 31. The drivers and Entrants were interviewed.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the results of the race.  
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 4

Additional Comments: Parties present were the drivers and entrants/team managers for Cars 26 and 31. Officials present were Clerk of the Course (Paul Levitt - 252266), Assistant Clerk of the Course (Kyle Jackson - 299245), and the Ginetta Junior driving standards advisor (Tom Onslow-Cole).

During this session, Car 26 departed the circuit following contact, and then rejoined towards the circuit, making heavy contact with Car 31 when approaching the circuit.

Those competitors present were Henry Joslyn (driver, car 26 - 392737), and Felix Livesey (driver, car 31 - 391249), and their team managers/entrants.

Evidence provided were verbal accounts from the drivers of Car 26 and 31.

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
