Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

C 1.1.5 Driving in a manner not compatible with general safety

Brief Details:

At 15:27:10 car 65 hit barrier at Turn 7 out, with yellow flag immediately shown at marshal post 19. This was upgraded to double waved yellow at 15:28:10 to allow a marshal trackside to attend the driver of 65. This in turn put a single waved yellow out at preceding post 18. On initial meeting Henry Neal stated he thought he was a bit fast past the crashed mustang (car 65). He also stated that he had seen the waved yellow before the apex. He stated that in the Lotus Cortina you have to steer with the rear wheels. I showed the circuit CCTV footage that showed that he was at least 3 wheels on the grass, sideways, and at one point heading in direction of marshal at side of the crashed car. I explained that i could see that he was not in full control of his vehicle under yellow flag and as such the guideline penalty is disqualification. The agravating situation of marshal trackside increased penalty to disqualification from the event. Just later the co-driver came and explained the difficulty with the handling of the car, but that in my view this would not change my decision.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from the meeting
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 6

Additional Comments: I am referring the matter to the stewards of the meeting for further consideration as offence is listed as C1.1.5

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
