Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q 12.21.4 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

### **Brief Details:**

In free practice approaching turn 1 car 22 made contact with the rear of car 600 causing both cars to leave the track and causing a red flag. Car 22 did not have any in car footage available so only circuit cctv reviewed. Driver of 22 stated that car 600 braked earlier than he anticipated however from cctv it is clear that car 22 made contact fully on the rear of 600 under braking.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Additional Comments: Championship regulation 4.2.3 refers, 50 championship point deduction and starts next race from the pitlane
