Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q 12.24.3 (e/f) Failure to comply with Yellow Flag signals

## **Brief Details:**

The driver of car 16 has complained that Car 67 over took under a yellow flag condition on the exit of the final turn on the last lap of the race. This was reviewed by myself in consultation with the Senior Clerk David Scott. Footage from both cars and the circuit CCTV was viewed. The footage from car 67 had a technical issue meaning the alleged incident could be heard but not seen. The footage from car 16 is of poor quality but appears to corroborate the circuit CCTV footage.

My decision is that:

Car 67 was likely unsighted on the yellow flag

Car 16 saw the yellow and responded to a nearby car slowing and braked in what would likely have appeared to be an erratic braking situation Car 67 passed car 16 before the yellow flag

Car 67 then saw the yellow flag and slowed and did not overtake the nearby car.

My decision is to take no further action.

Both drivers were interviewed.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

No Further Action

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
