Q 12.24.3 (e/f) Failure to comply with Yellow Flag signals

**Brief Details:**  
Driver had just come out of pit lane. Track conditions had changed from previous lap on track. Driver passed single (drivers left) and double yellow (drivers right) lights just before spinning on fluid. Given change in surface and angle of sun light, mitigating circumstances reduces penalty.
