Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Series Regulation(s):

5.16.2 Series changing or swapping wheels/tyres

### **Brief Details:**

Car 22 changed wheels in the pit lane during the qualifying session which is not permitted under the series regulations, unless on the grounds of safety. Wheels were checked by scrutineers, but were deemed safe with not signs of damage. As a result I find Car 22 guilty of breaching series regulation 5.16.2.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

All laps times removed from the qualifying session, competitor permitted to start from the back of the grid, in front of guest class cars with a 10 second delay

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
