Following investigation and having heard evidence from the competitor I find that, you are found guilty of contravening Motorsport UK Regulation (s):

Q12.21.4 Causing a collision, repetition of **serious** mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Following a loss of control the driver of car 22 was overtaken. Having regained control he proceeded at speed down the wellington straight. At the end of the straight he caught up with car 44 who had overtaken him and made front to rear contact.

Having interviewed both drivers and viewed video footage from a car running behind it was clear that the contact was unnecessary
