Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Eligibility - Post Race Scrutineering

### **Brief Details:**

Following both races the vehicle data logging system was interrogated and the power was found to be 175 on both occasions. Championship Regulation 25.11 allows the organisers to test power using a data logging system. Appendix 1 lists the relevant power and I confirmed with the competitor that the vehicle is a 2001 Porsche Boxter S 3.2 for which the power is listed as a maximum of 162. The competitor was invited to other reasons but claimed the regulations do not allow for the matter to be dealt with this way. He has received the non-compliance form and the data sheet provided.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

C3.5.1 (a) The event will be counted as one of the events contributing to their total Championship score and (b) The Competitor will be disqualified from the event, forfeiting all Championship points, prize money and other awards
