Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q 12.24.3 (e/f) Failure to comply with Yellow Flag signals

Brief Details:

During qualifying session car in gravel just before Old Hairpin. Double yellow flag displayed in Craner curves. Car 85 overtook car 5 before incident and before green flag at Old Hairpin. Video from car 5 showed marshals in gravel on way to incident but some way away. Action limited disqualified from qualifying

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from qualifying - allowed to start at back with 10 second delay (Q12.9.4 refers)
Number of Licence Penalty Points: 4

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
