C 3.3 Eligibility - Post Practice Scrutineering

### **Brief Details:**

Car 24 reported by scrutineer as being under weight after qualifying. Found to be 1381kg against regulation weight of 1390kg. Driver interviewed who explained they believed they fuelled incorrectly due to feul gauge issue. However, this was not considered an exceptional circumstance.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Disqualified from qualifying session

Additional Comments: Car 24 may start from back of grid with a 10 second delay.
