Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q 12.21.4 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car (such as leaving the track) will be reported to the Clerk of Course and may entail the imposition of penalties up to and including the disqualification of any driver concerned.

Brief Details:

Approaching Druids corner, Car 1 moved to the right of Car 94, to pass at the entry to the corner. At the same time, Car 94 had been moving across to take the apex for Druids. Contact occured with both cars, resulting in both cars ending up in the gravel trap. Car 94 remined in the gravel trap, Car 1 continued.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Additional Comments: After investigation using the onboard videos, it was determined that neither competitor was wholly or predomintaly to blame, with it being declared a racing incident.
