### **Brief Details:**

Car 53 passed Car 17 between the Yellow Flag shown at Post 8 and the Green Flag shown at Post 9.

The pass took place well after the incident and just prior to the Green Flag. Driver admitted that he judged the timing of the pass incorrectly.
