**Brief Details:**

At Macleans corner (T7), Car 3 was observed to pass Car 47 whilst under Safety Car flag conditions. At the time, Car 3 was racing with Car 4 & Car 22. Car 47 had slowed significantly as the pass occurred.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
