### **Brief Details:**

Car 73 overtook Car 40 under the safety car at the bottom of the Craner Curves. Car 40 raised his hand to indicate that he'd seen the safety car flags and boards, however this was mistaken by Car 73 as a mechanical problem for Car 40. This has been taken into account as mitigating circumstances. My decision is to penalise you with a 1 place position penalty.
