Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q 12.24.3 (e/f) Failure to comply with Yellow Flag signals

Brief Details:

Car 40 Patrick Sherrington overtook car 5 Richard Johnson under S/C conditions at Coram Turn 11 whilst SC Boards Lights / Flags were being displayed at Posts 18 and 19 and as was confirmed by the timekeepers. Positions were maintained following the end of the Safety Car period. Driver interviewed and mitigating circumstances given that Car 40 was running in close nose to tail proximity to Car 5 into T11 and was focused on the rear of Car 5 and the racing line and did not see the light panels and flags on the outside of T11 which are quite a way back from the track and out of the drivers line of vision. Driver was then aware as he approached T12 when he saw the Lights / Flags on Post 20 Murrays.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
