Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK Regulation(s):

Q 12.24.3 (e/f) Failure to comply with Yellow Flag signals

### **Brief Details:**

Car 87 overtook car 46 whilst passing the incident. Flags were clearly displayed at the preceding posts. Although car 46 braked hard, car 87 maintained a high throttle whilst passing. No redress was seen following the yellow sector. The pass occurred next to the incident.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK Regulation G 5.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

150 second time penalty in lieu of a 2 minute stop go penalty as prescribed in the championship regulations

You are reminded of your right of appeal. Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with Motorsport UK Regulation C 2.1.4
