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With four rounds already completed, this weekend at Oulton Park marks the season finale for the 7 Racing Championship.

An exciting day ahead will see champions crowned in the 270R, 310R and 420R classes, but not before plenty of action from these Caterham experts.

Starting with the 270R class, Myrton Wood has enjoyed a superb season. Dominant from the start, Wood looks set to enjoy another strong outing at Oulton Park this weekend, at a circuit he knows well.

With three wins to his name so far this year, David Yates currently sits atop of the 310R championship standings. After being a strong contender in 2023 for title honours, he will be keen to try and take the mantle this season. However, with strong competition in the form of second placed man James Wingfield, it will be no easy task. The pair have battled profusely all season, and that looks set to continue at Oulton Park this weekend.

Fraser Riddington is in third place in the title race at the moment, narrowly ahead of Caterham stalwart Caroline Everett and Tim Steel. There are still plenty of championship positions to be decided throughout the 310R grid, and this weekend will decipher them perfectly.

Onto the 420R Championship and Anthony Barnes looks set to retain his title. After claiming championship

honours at Oulton Park last year, another dominant performance this season should see him hold onto top spot. However, he will have tough competition from Mark Stansfield, who, after finishing second on many occasions this season, is hoping to finally secure that illusive win.

Behind Barnes in the title race, Stewart Calder is currently in second place, ahead of Ian Cowley. Fourth place man Lee Wiggins returns this weekend. A race winner already throughout the season, Wiggins' distinctive green machine will likely be challenging for race wins this weekend and will certainly be a name to watch out for.

As well as looking set for a top three position in the overall 420R championship, Cowley currently leads the way in the 420R Sportsman competition. A strong season has seen Cowley secure an unrivalled number of podium finishes in the Sportsman championship, giving him a comfortable advantage heading into this season finale.

Matt Reeve holds onto second place at the moment, with a slight advantage over third placed Tom Greensall. After claiming not only his first podium finish, but his first victory last time out at Silverstone, Greensall will be keen to climb to the top step of the podium once again this weekend.


As ever you can expect some thrilling action from the 7 Racing Championship here at Oulton Park. Caterham racing is never boring!





The 2024 Teekay Couplings Production GTi championship Top spots are currently shared amongst PGTi veteran Simon Hill and Rookie sensation Henry Riley. Both drivers are currently tied on 114 points going into the season finale.

Production GT

James Colbourne is poised in third place on 99 points ready to upset the party, along with a resurgent Richard Marsh, who returns to Oulton Park with a fresh new front bumper after a brush with the tyre wall at Paddock Hill bend. Adam Hance and Chris Webb always go well at Oulton Park, so look out for them pressing the front spots.

Paul Blackburn and John Beale, who are good friends frequently attend track days with one another in a variety of fast machinery, they will be looking to continue their competitive natures, on track in their Red MK5 GTi's. Watch out for the inevitable close battle, will Blackburns DSG equipped car, have the advantage on the lengthy Oulton Park track. Danny Jones and Gavin Drake, both found time at the previous rounds and will be looking to capitalise on this and taking the fight to Beale and Blackburn.

Following the success of Betsy the MK2 16v at Brands Hatch, Oulton Park welcomes the return of MK2 drivers Dean Clayton and John Mawdsley. They will both be looking to take the MK2 top-spot away from Betsy, who again is Piloted by Championship Co-ordinator Rob Sadler.

All of the MK2s will be running in the invitational class, with Sadler and Mawdsleys running to the original PGTi regulations and Claytons running more power and less weight, so maybe Clayton will be mixing it with the more Powerful turbo charged MK5 GTi's..... it's all to play for!

2021 saw the introduction of the very modern MK7 GTI package. There is the option to choose either 3 or 5 door cars, in either manual or DSG configuration.



The Cockshoot Cup races today are races five and six of an eight round championship for 2024.


The Cockshoot Cup is a silver trophy presented by the MG dealers in Manchester to the North West Centre in 1934. Since 1984 the Cockshoot Cup has been awarded to the winner of the race championship run by the Centre for MG Cars. Today rounds five and six of the eight races for 2024 are being run with the remaining two being at Silverstone on September 29th. There are four classes, Class A being for MG ZR170s, Class B for MGBs and MG Midgets running on road tyres, Class F for standard MGFs and Class C for any MG running on racing tyres.

The Championship is celebrating forty years today with a reunion of former drivers. There has been at least one race at Oulton Park every year that the Championship has been run.

Championship leader after four rounds is the defending champion Dave Morrison who drives an MG Midget in Class C. His main opposition today will come from the MGF engine Midget of Keith Egar, Ray Collier's MG ZR190, Peter Bramble's MGB and a host of the MGF Cup Cars driven by the likes of Karl Green, David Coulthard and Lloyd Tredell. Class A has been dominated this season by the pink MG ZR170 driven by Leon Wignall. Competition today will come from Mark Bellamy and our two lady drivers Helen Waddington and Eliza Seville. The dicing in Class F will be between Gareth Jones and Phil "Riggers" Rigby.

FLAGS

BLUE (STEADY)

Another competitor is close.

BLUE (WAVED)

Another competitor is trying to pass.

WHITE

Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit.

YELLOW (WAVED)

Danger, slow down sufficiently to ensure that full control of the vehicle can be retained. No overtaking.

YELLOW (DOUBLE WAVED)

Great danger. Slow down considerably. Be prepared to suddenly change from the projected racing line, or take other evasive action including stopping if necessary. No overtaking. (This signal may be supplemented or replaced by flashing yellow light(s), as an added warning).

YELLOW/RED STRIPES

Slippery surface ahead.

GREEN (WAVED)

All dear, at the end of a danger area controlled by yellow flags. Also used to signal the start of a formation lap and shown at all posts during first lap of each practice session and during the formation lap.

RED

STOP RACING, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by marshals (at startline & individual marshal's posts). Race stopped.

BLACK/ORANGE DISK

Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to driver; call into pits immediately.

BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL


Warning to driver that his/her behaviour (e.g. corner cutting) is suspect and he/her may be black flagged.


BLACK

Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of the Course.

BLACK & WHITE CHEQUERED

End of the race.
