According to the Judicial Procedures of the 2024 MCRCB Sporting Code we confirm our decision.

Motive

During Snetterton British Sportbike Free practice 1, your were observed to have loose bodywork. You were shown the black and orange flag and LED light signal at multiple points, but continued at racing speed for more than 4 minutes. This is an infringement of Article C 1.4.3 of the 2024 MCRCB Sporting Code. Due to the prolonged hazard presented to yourself and other riders, it is considered a serious infringement.

Hearing

You were required to attend a hearing with the Race Direction and acknowledged the incident.

Sanction

According to Article F 2.8.3 of the 2024 MCRCB Judicial Procedures, it is the decision of Race Direction that you be penalised with 4 penalty points.

Right of Appeal

According to Art. F 7 of the MCRCB Judicial Code, you have the right to appeal against this decision to the MCRCB Stewards within 30 minutes of the date and time of receipt of this decision. The appeal must be lodged in writing, stating the grounds for the appeal and accompanied by the appeal fee of £250.
