The Stewards heard evidence from the following persons:

James Wingfield; David Yates; live stream footage; on-board video from both cars.

The Stewards decision is:

to find that David Yates was in breach of Q 12.21.4 and award a 10-place position penalty for the 7 Racing - 310R & 270 - Race 3.

3 points are to be added to Mr Yates licence (271613)

Reason(s) for this decision:

This appeal, heard at Silverstone on 28th July 2024, arises from an incident at Donington Park on 30th June 2024. The Stewards' Panel today have received delegated authority to conduct this hearing from the Event Stewards at Donington on 30th June.

Mr Wingfield appeals the severity of the penalty awarded to Mr Yates following a contact between their two cars in the final lap of their third race.

Both cars were vying for the race win and it was undisputed that contact between their two cars at the chicane resulted in race-ending damage to Mr Wingfield's car. Mr Yates went on to be the first car in this race to take the chequered flag.

The Stewards found that the Decision of the CoC was to award "Addition of time to your race time" (but the amount of time was not cited). An additional comment on the Decision is "10 place position penalty".

The provisional results published for this Race reveal that the Timekeeper applied a 10-lap penalty to Mr Yates resulting in him being non-classified.

From this hearing the Stewards are satisfied that Mr Yates was predominantly responsible for the collision that occurred and is, therefore, in breach of Q 12.21.4. Mr Yates is given the penalty cited above.

The Stewards instruct the Timekeepers to correct the provisional results and to apply the penalty cited above.

Mr Wingfield's Appeal Fee is forfeit.

Decision verbally advised to Mr Wingfield and Mr Yates at 09.57hrs and were both reminded of their right of appeal.
