In the Bennetts British Superbike Championhip, Tarran Mackenzie will return to defend his crown, whilst there is plenty of local interest in the Kwik Fit British Touring Car Championship following the recent confirmation that Wrotham's Motorbase Performance will run a superteam of Ashley Sutton and Dan Cammish.

Full details of the upcoming season will be finalised in the coming weeks, with confirmed dates and ticket prices already confirmed for American SpeedFest 9, GT World Challenge Europe, major historic events, and much more.



2022 Brands Hatch race calendar confirmed

The provisional 2022 race calendars for all five of MSV's circuits, including Brands Hatch, have been confirmed ahead of another packed season of events on two and four wheels across the country.

Brands Hatch will host more than its fair share of the best that UK motorsport has to offer between now and the end of the year, with countless headline events. These will include two rounds each of the Bennetts British Superbike Championship and Kwik Fit British Touring Car Championship, plus GT World Challenge Europe which returns on 30 April/1 August.



Other major championships to visit will include the Intelligent Money British GT Championship and GB3 Championship partnered by the BRDC, plus Time Attack UK and the British Truck Racing Championship. The NASCAR Whelen Euro Series returns too, headlining American SpeedFest 9 at Brands Hatch on 11-12 June amidst



another summer of family-friendly themed festivals.

There will be special historic and vintage events too, displaying many facets of motor racing's golden past, whilst a packed club event schedule on two and four wheels ensures that there is something to see most weekends from March until November.

Exciting season ahead for local BTCC teams and drivers

There will be plenty of local interest in this year's Kwik Fit British Touring Car Championship, following the exciting driver news over the off-season from Wrotham's Motorbase Performance team and Kent racer Jake Hill.

Motorbase will run reigning champion Ashley Sutton on this year's grid as it chases a first outright crown in the country's leading four-wheeled championship. Sutton will be joined in a race-winning line-up by returning ace Dan Cammish who came very close to sealing the crown at Brands Hatch in 2019.

Tunbridge Wells ace Jake Hill will join West Surrey Racing's crack BMW outfit for 2022 as he continues to establish himself as one of the BTCC's regular frontrunners.

2022 Traffic Management Information

Brands Hatch would like to notify residents of traffic management plans for the 2022 season. A major event traffic management system will be operated on the following dates:

• Sunday 17 April (British Truck Racing Championship)

• Sunday 1 May (GT World Challenge Europe)

• Sunday 15 May (British Touring Car Championship)

• Sunday 12 June (American Speedfest 9)

• Saturday 23/Sunday 24 June (British Superbike Championship)

• Sunday 11 September (British GT Championship, Featuring GB3)

• Sunday 9 October (British Touring Car Championship)

• Saturday 15/Sunday 16 October (British Superbike Championship)

• Sunday 6 November (British Truck Racing and Fireworks)

These plans will result in the partial closure of Scratchers Lane from Gabrielspring Road to the junction with the A20 at Gorse Hill from approximately 1500 until 1900. Traffic shall not be able to turn into Scratchers Lane from the A20 at Gorse Hill during this time.

A 30mph speed limit will also be in operation from Twenty Mile Service Station in West Kingsdown to the start of the new 40mph zone on the approach to Farningham. This 30mph speed limit will be in operation from approximately 0630 until 1900.
